

**ANALYSIS LANGUAGE ENVIRONMENT OF ENGLISH DEPARTMENT AT
MADURA UNIVERSITY IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNING**

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Abstract:

The aim of this research to describe the naturalness of environment on English speaking skills at English study program Madura University. This research is qualitative research by using narrative. Researched obtained data from, observation, interview and documentation. The research informants were the sixth semester of English Study Program at Madura University academic 2021/2022.

Based on the result of the study show the students in the English study program feel in the English study program feel insecure when speaking in public, mix English and Indonesian when the student don't know the vocabulary. The English study program does not have a language laboratory facility that helps students to develop their abilities, the students often communicate with their classmates and with teacher, but when talking to the lecturer most are afraid of being wrong. Students only talk in class and during class. When, outside class rarely to speak English.

Introduction

English is a very important subject in this era of globalization. As we can see that English has become an international language where almost all countries have made English the language of daily communication. There are four basic language skill such as, listening, speaking, reading, and writing, but the researcher focus on speaking skill. ability in using English is still low. The use of English is only used when they are studying English subjects in class, without being practiced directly in daily communication like other countries. Various ways have been tried to improve students' English speaking skills, but the results have not been too significant, because the courage to speak using English is very low. They are more likely to be afraid of being laughed at if they mispronounce or use words. Mostly, students who have good English speaking skills are students who are educated in high quality schools where both the school and family environment is very supportive of their development and most of them are in urban areas. Meanwhile, students who only study in remote areas have minimal facilities and infrastructure and the lack of support from the surrounding environment causes learning to tend to be low in English skills, even though English has been studied since junior high school. They only dare to use English when they are

in class, the rest they prefer to be silent rather than communicate in English.

This problem is not only for junior high or high school students but this also happens to English students, especially English students at the Faculty of Teacher Training and Education, Madura University. Even though they are English students, they still have a fear of always practicing using English. Shame overcame their courage in stringing words together in English. In addition, shame also arises due to responses from the surrounding environment that do not support their desire to always communicate using English. Where when they speak English with their friends, sometimes people will think that they are arrogant students because they are considered to show their intelligence. This is one of the barriers for students to improve their speaking skills in using English.

Based on the description above, the researcher are interested in studying and researching how does the naturalness of language environment. This is due to a lack of self-confidence to apply the knowledge gained in everyday life, especially in the ability to speak. So, the researcher puts it forward in the form of a scientific paper entitled "Analysis Language Environment of English Department at Madura University in English Language Learning".

Research Method

This research is qualitative research by using narrative. Narrative in qualitative research in dept explorations of bound system. It can also be an activity, event process or individual, based on extensive data collection (craswell,1997). This research is qualitative research to aim describing the naturalness of language environment in the English study

program at Madura University in english speaking skills.

1. Naturalness of the Environment

The findings of this research show the students in the English study program feel insecure when speaking in public.

Confidence and competence in speaking could be developed from appropriate syllabus design, methods of teaching, and sufficient tasks and materials (Boonkit, K. 2010: 1306).

2. The Learner'S Role in Communication

The findings of this research show the students mix English and Indonesian when the students don't know the vocabulary.

These kinds of findings permit us to suggest that communication situations in which students are permitted to remain silent or respond in their first language may be the most effective approach for the early phases of language instruction. This approach approximates what language learners of all ages have ben observed to do naturally, and it appears to be more effective than forcing full two-way communication from the very beginning of second language acquisition (Heidy, Dulay. at al. 1982:25-26)

3. Availability of Concrete Referent

The findings of this research show the English study program does not have a language laboratory facility that helps students to develop their abilities.

The school learning infrastructure provides a base for effective teaching and learning in schools and ensuring successful education. The school facilities like library, administration offices and water, administration offices and classroom, laboratory and classroom had the highest ProductMoment Correlation Coefficient (PMCC) and showed positive association (Arshad, M., Ahmed, G., & Tayyab, M. 2019:215).

4. Target Language Models

The findings of this research show the students often communicate with their classmates and with the teacher, but when talking to the lecturer most are afraid of being wrong. Students only talk in class and during class. When, outside class rarely to speak English.

“Inhibition, students are worried about making mistakes, fearful of criticism, or simply shy. Nothing to say, students have no motive to express themselves. Low or uneven participation, only one participant can talk at a time because of large classes and the tendency of some learners to dominate, while others speak very little or not at all. (Al-Roud, A. A. 2016: 2).

Finally, the result of this research found that the students of English at Madura University, The students only in accordance with the one appearance that affects the ability to speak English, namely the Learner's Role in Communication.

Conclusion

Role of the environment on the speaking skills of students in the English study program at Madura University.

This study aims to describe the result of the four broader overall appearances that affect the quality of second language acquisition, especially speaking ability; The students only in accordance with the one appearance that affects the ability to speak English, namely the Learner's Role in Communication. About Naturalness The environment, Naturalness The environment did not run well, because the students were still not confident when speaking in public places especially in English study program yard. About Availability of Concrete Referent, English Education Study Program only has classroom facilities, and a library, but does not have a language laboratory.
